Correspondence issued by the Secretary to Members was Minutes of ESOS General Meeting 19 April; Update to New Class Descriptions incl pictures April 2021.

#### **BENCHING CLASSES:**

The new benching classes were discussed and the alignment of table cards with the new class descriptions and related colour coding Open (pink); Novice (green) and Junior (blue). The Secretary issued a single page update to the benching class descriptions with pictures to correct a error for Novice Class 30 Dendrobium Hybrids and the related description which now reads 'Dendrobium Hybrids with no Australian parentage or background'.

It was further agreed that a benching class document would be issued next meeting without pictures by the Secretary.

it was introduced into Europe in the late 1800's by the orchid hunters sent out by the great hoses of Europe.

Its native range is Assam (Meghalaya) to China (NW. Yunnan).

*Paphiopedilum insigne* grows on cliffs near water at elevations of 910 to 1500 meters. The area is cool with good light with high rainfall in summer but dry and humid conditions in winter.

This makes it a cool grower ideal for the Sydney climate and it quickly grows into specimine plants.



Paph. spicerianum. Warleiti Jap Paph. spicerianum is found ifrom Bhutan to Yunan in China.

This is also a species suited to Sydney conditions. There is need for care in purchasing it as there are many plants that are being sold that are hybrids. The shield just above the pouch is an inicator of the species.

*Cattleya* Vinosa - Gavin Curtis This one was an interesting proble. It was benchd as C. G. Roebling X C. labiata.

Due to name changes there are 2 orchids named Cattleya C. G. Roebling 1895 and Cattleya C. G. Roebling 1916. When this happens they put the year of registration after the name. However most of the time the year is lost. It is particularly contensious when the breeding is similar. as in this example.

There was only the one crossed in 1895 was crossed with C. labiata resulting in C. Vinosa. C. Vinosa is an old hybrid registered in 1926
