Benching Plants: the Treasurer reminded members of the importance of pre-meeting preparation to determine the correct name of plants to be benched and their relevant class category and that exhibitors of plants at a meeting must be present at the meeting. It was noted at the time of judging that some plants were incorrectly categorised causing judges to have to repeat judging of a number of categories. The People's Choice Award was not conducted at the meeting. There was a raffle of the night held and a number of Members won plants. Warleiti displayed her *Paphiopedilum* Tatonka

to members and discussed care tips including outdoor placement except in Winter and use of regular fertilizer. Kalliopi Kalogerakis displayed her Cattleya unknown and the regular use of dynamic lifter to generate growth.
