

There were no new members present.

MINUTES:

The minutes issued of the previous face to face general meeting and Christmas party of the

19th December 2022 were accepted as a true and accurate record and were seconded by Ian Kaplin. No changes to the minutes were requested by attendee members.

MEMBERSHIP:

Membership was discussed and currently number twenty three for 2023. This number will be used for the purposes of renewal of Public Liability Insurance by the Treasurer which has been subsequently advised as paid. Discussion followed on recruitment of new members going forward and ideas to be further developed.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The Treasurer outlined cash on hand for the Society and identified that the ESOS continues to remain financially viable, although during COVID expenses exceeded income in the absence of any income from shows, which were highlighted as essential for ongoing financial viability.

It was noted that the request sent by the ESOS Secretary to The Orchid Society of NSW in December 2022 regarding outstanding payment of profit sharing from the Southern Orchid Spectacular held in October 2022 was resolved with the funds released to ESOS as confirmed by the ESOS Treasurer.

UPCOMING SHOWS:

The Secretary informed members of the list of upcoming shows in the Agenda which are many and dates/times should be confirmed before planning to attend.

The Orchids Central Show was discussed and the ESOS participation in this show was agreed by Members. It was noted that this includes the ESOS Treasurer as the Treasurer for the Show and that one other person from the ESOS is required to participate possibly as The Secretary.

The ESOS Secretary called for those interested in being on the Orchid Central Organising Committee (at least one additional person from ESOS) to please inform the Secretary before the next ESOS General Meeting on 20th March 2022. The Organising Committee meets on the first Friday of every month.

A further action arising was for the Treasurer to pay \$500 to the Orchids Central Show Account confirming the intent of ESOS as a participating partner in the Orchids Central Organising Committee. Chin Wong has advised that this has been actioned in early March 2023.

The ESOS Orchid Show at Flower Power at Botany has commenced with Planning. The President requested the assistance of Herbert Chen and Chao Ping Li on signage design. It was noted that no date has yet been determined

ESOS OFFICE BEARERS

Gavin Curtis advised the meeting members and gave notice that he wishes to resign from the position of President and his resignation was tendered in writing on 3rd March 2023, which was formally accepted by the Secretary on behalf of the ESOS.

The Secretary has called for nominations for the role of President which will be discussed at the next General Meeting on 20th March 2023

PRESENTATION & TALK

Ian Chalmers delivered a 30 minute presentation on Paphiopedilum and the wide variety of hybridization of the orchid species. The presentation included photographs and other information. Many thanks to Ian on his efforts and interesting presentation.

OTHER BUSINESS

ALL NOTE: Venue Hall Hire It was highlighted to Members that the St Luke's Hall is scheduled to undergo renovation in 2023 and that the ESOS lease may extend only up to September/October. Discussion followed on other venues.

A number of members committed to making enquiries on Halls or other suitable venues in their area which will be discussed at the next meeting on 20th March 2023.

PLANT OF THE NIGHT:

The Plant of the Night Open Category was awarded to Ross Trethewy for his *Cymbidium dayanum* and the Plant of the Night Novice Category was awarded to Chao Ping Li for her *Bratonia Estelita*. 'Sweet Sinorita' Congratulations to both members on their outstanding plants.

RAFFLE:

The Raffle was held and many thanks to Elizabeth Ying who donated a large *Dendrobium speciosum* as a raffle prize.

JUDGING:



SUPPER ROSTER:


The Supper was discussed. Would members please email Gavin Curtis (gavininsydney@hotmail.com) if they are willing to participate in the roster.
